### Part 2 – Interview

#### **A:**

Imagine you are the manager of a shoe store (or other type of shop or business). Ask your partner five questions for a job interview, using the present perfect, for example, *Have you ever stolen from an employer?*

Your partner **must** answer “Yes, I have.” Ask him two more specific questions. Take notes about his answers.

#### **B:**

Imagine you are the candidate for a job. You are going to do a job interview with your partner. You **must** answer “Yes, I have” to **all** his questions. When he asks you for more questions, use your imagination to make up the details.

***When A has finished asking the five questions, change roles. B is the manager and A is the candidate.***
